India-Indonesia-Australia Trilateral Maritime Exercise

The indigenously built warship INS Sahyadri participated in the maritime partnership exercise with aircraft and ships from the Indonesian Navy and the Royal Australian Navy in the Indo-Pacific region from September 20-21. Cross-deck landings, cross-deck visits of integral helicopters and Complex tactical and maneuvering exercises were conducted for enhancement of interoperability and training of crews between these maritime nations.
