Chinese Fighter Jet nearly collides into U.S. B-52 bomber

In a night-time manoeuvre over the South China Sea a Chinese fighter jet nearly caused a collision and came within 10 feet of a U.S. B-52 bomber. The U.S. Indo-Pacific Command said that the pilot of the Chinese fighter jet "flew in an unsafe and unprofessional manner" and with "uncontrolled excessive speed".
