French Navy Kicks off La Perouse 2025 Exercise in East Indian Ocean (16 Jan)

The La Perouse exercise brings together nine countries including Canada, United States, United Kingdom, India, Indonesia, Australia, and Singapore and is led by France. The main objective of the exercise are to "provide maritime safety with regional partners and multinational coalition assests in the 3 main straits detrimental to commercial shipping", and to secure strategic sea lines of communication in the Indo-Pacific.
